#### FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

Keep children away from flames and heat sources such as stoves, burning candles, fire pits, or BBQs. Store matches and lighters in a safe place and teach young children not to touch them if they find one.

Teach children how to Stop, Drop, and Roll on the ground if their clothes catch on fire. They should cover their face with their hands and roll back and forth until the fire is out.
