Pretzels

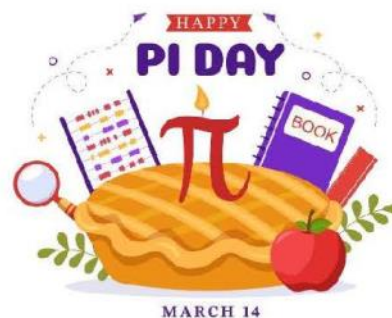
